

Proverbs 25:2 It is the glory of God to conceal a thing; but the honour of kings is to search out a matter.

Luke is a good example of this scripture. Luke exposed so much of the Glory of God it amazes me. Luke deserves the honor of a king because he searched out the matter. How much did he search out? All of the Gospel of Luke and part of the Book of Acts Luke searched out through eyewitnesses. He heard eyewitnesses tell Acts 4:20 For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard. Later in Acts 16:10 he recorded himself as a participant.

Every man owes it to himself to search out God's Oath in the books of Luke. Study until it is clear. Luke is clear! Early history Scholars give Luke high praise for being an intelligent Greek. However they miss the message of this Spirit filled Apostolic writer of God's Word. Luke is more than just an intelligent Greek. Luke has searched out things God has concealed from the wise and prudent but desires to reveal unto us - even yet today. In his heart Luke preached every word to Theophilus as he was inspired by the Holy Ghost to write it. Luke was not an early participant but received valid information from eyewitnesses. God confirmed it with His Oath of - surely I did it - when He inspired Luke to write it into the scriptures.

Luke 1:1 Forasmuch as many have taken in hand to set forth in order a declaration of those things which are most surely believed among us,

2 Even as they delivered them unto us, which from the beginning were eyewitnesses, and ministers of the word;

3 It seemed good to me also, having had perfect understanding of all things from the very first, to write unto thee in order, most excellent Theophilus,

4 That thou mightest know the certainty of those things, wherein thou hast been instructed.

In Acts 16:10 Luke was called to preach the Word in Philippi. He fulfilled this calling for six or seven years and then went from Philippi to Jerusalem with Paul on his third and final missionary journey. In Jerusalem Paul got in trouble with the Jews who hated him for betraying them. Paul was arrested, taken to Caesarea and put in jail for two years. During this two year period Luke was free at street level to interview eyewitnesses of the Christian Church who were there from the beginning. Luke wrote the Gospel of Luke during this two year period. The above information of Luke's journey comes from Luke himself. Think about that.

Sometimes we think we know but there is always so much more to be learned. The history book is not always the best place to look. The best any historian can do is to give you information you can test. First taste and see. Does it sound good? Will it pass the test of being forever settled in heaven? The Bible is set. Historians are not.

1 Corinthians 2:12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.

When a man gets hungry for God he must first empty out his pride. Then he learns things about God that are joy unspeakable.

There is no room for God in a person who is full of himself. Pride does this. The word trinity appears in history, not the Bible. It was invented by a man who wanted to change from the original baptism in Jesus Name to his mistaken interpretation of Matthew 28:19 where Jesus spoke the fullness of His Name. Matthew 28:19 is a parable, as all His parables were, to the unbelievers present.
