You are the witness for this Generation.

Luke 24:46 And said unto them, Thus it is written, and thus it behoved Christ to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day: 47 And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. 48 And **ye are witnesses of these things.**

I was raised in that home on the rebellious side. In 1947, when I was 17, there were 10 of us kids and I was number two so we all were at our country home yet. I couldn't change my birth certificate but I found out they would accept me in the Army Air Force if I had a baptismal certificate. There were two of us that needed this proof of age to enlist. We went to a country circuit preacher. He sprinkled us and gave us a certificate. When he asked when I was born I lied making my age 18.

That is not the worst thing I did. I won't tell you the worst thing because it's all under the Blood. But I will tell you this. I just could not make a good sinner. I could only go so far and I would chicken out. My father and my mother were praying for me. When I would think of back home my mental pictures were of my praying parents.

This battle went on inside me for two and one half years. I was promoted three times and was a Sergeant. Six months before I was honorably discharged I visited a small church in Enid, Oklahoma where I was stationed. It was a Sunday Evening Service. When they started the service the feeling of being a visitor left me. I was hearing the sound of Pentecostal music. Not long after that I got the Holy Ghost speaking with tongues. When I arrived at home on August 1, 1950 I was baptized in Jesus Name.

It is important that you make a clear witness. My Dad was a coal miner with a third grade education. He was never ashamed of his salvation. He made a faithful witness to me and many others in his lifetime. He was born August 12, 1885 and died at 89 in 1974.

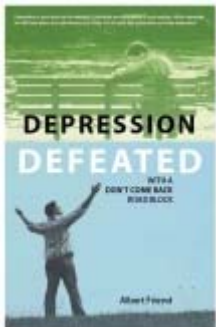
