

2 Peter 1:1 to them that have obtained like precious faith.

Jesus gave the answers to Peter. Peter relayed the answers on the Day of Pentecost. The keys to the kingdom are, Repent and be baptized everyone of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. Jesus required this in Luke 24:46-47. If you use the keys the door will open. It is your user name and password.

2 Peter 1:12 Wherefore I will not be negligent to put you **always in remembrance** of these things, though ye know them, and be established in *the present truth*.

13 Yea, I think it meet, as long as I am in this tabernacle, to stir you up by **putting you in remembrance**;

14 Knowing that shortly I must put off this my tabernacle, even as our Lord Jesus Christ hath shewed me.

15 Moreover I will endeavour that ye may be able *after my decease* to have these things **always in remembrance**.

I have traveled to the many places where the Church was started and later expanded to. I have been in Israel from north, the sea of Galilee, to south, the Dead Sea, from east, the Jordan River, to west, the Mediterranean Sea.

I have been in Damascus, Syria and seen the Street called Straight. It is straight. I have visited the seven Churches in Asia and viewed many sights in Athens, Greece, including Mars' Hill where Paul preached the oneness message telling them, "in him we live and move and have our being." I have been in Rome and the southern parts of Italy. The Message of Peter on Pentecost was the same in **all that World**.

It is recorded on a time line in the Bible and cannot be erased. Light records a path everywhere it has been, including the Cross, and cannot be extinguished. It is a judgment record we will all meet. We will see ourselves recorded on it and be judged by our deeds. The wonderful part is Jesus remitted His Blood as payment for our sins. God has blotted out our sins to be remembered no more. Our sins are no longer on the books. His Blood is our conscience. When we repent He forgives immediately. Only our good deeds remain on the books. **Jesus is going to make us look good in the judgment**. That is the reason we must carry this present truth into the future.

Our salvation also appears on this same time line. Peter is recorded on the day of Pentecost. My salvation is recorded in March of 1950. Truth cannot change; therefore, I obeyed Acts 2:38. Fifty Seven years later I carry the same burden of the man who taught me, the Apostle Peter. It is as though he were alive today. He extended his burden into future generations, even into ours. **The burden of Peter** is still to be reckoned with. Jesus Christ is the same, yesterday, today and forever. Dates mean nothing to Truth. You do not need to sort back through 2000 years of history to find the truth. The truth is recorded on the pages of the New Testament in the English language for all to see.

Philippians 3:13 Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before,

14 I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.

Hebrews 13:16 But to do good and to **communicate forget not**: for with such sacrifices **God is well pleased**.

Everything is out ahead of us. The Apostolic Cutting Edge is leading us to it. There are souls along the way we need to introduce to this wonderful Plan of Salvation. Speak up. Speak Truth. Speak clear. The Message is clear when it is spoken clear.
