Psalms 19:7. The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple. When God created the universe He created it perfect. He upholds it all with the word of His power. His Word works perfectly in the thing He designed it to do.

Seest thou how faith wrought with his works, and by works was faith made perfect? The Grace of God in its purest form is to allow us to do the works of faith to make our faith perfect.

Getting Good at What We Do!

Every profession has a discipline: the doctor, the lawyer, the baker, the candlestick maker all must follow the discipline of their profession. There is also a need for discipline in the field of being a Christian. The key to this discipline is obedience on our part.

The tools we have to work with are God's word. He has given us dominion in this area and we can have what we say. The discipline necessary to accomplish this is the subject of this study.

Let me show you obedience as God sees it. Hebrews 5:8 Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered.

The suffering referred to here is, "suffer is to be so." When God looks on us in our weaker moments He "suffers it to be so". He believes we will come back around in a repenting spirit as Peter did when he denied Jesus three times. God trusts us and He wants us to trust one another and "suffer some things to be so." Let things alone. Don't get angry. Trust in your weaker brother. Don't interrupt the flow in the kingdom.

Trust in God and His word and then in your fellow man. With this kind of trust you will TAKE THE RESPONSIBILITY of saying God's word with the authority that He has given you. Let me remind you that to have authority you must be under authority and "suffer some things to be so."

Romans 8:26 Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

Romans 10:6. :But the righteousness which is of faith speaketh on this wise, Say not in thine heart, Who shall ascend into heaven? (that is, to bring Christ down from above:) 7. :Or, Who shall descend into the deep? (that is, to bring up Christ again from the dead.) 8. :But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach;
