

The Principle of Agreement

Matthew 18:19 if two of you shall agree

Two are involved. You and God, you and another person, and this scripture.

1. Find your Partner.
2. See the promise together.
3. Agree with it.
4. Pursue it.

God gave us a Partner for the worst times in life. How good of a partner can you be, first to God and then to the person in your agreement.

Matt 18:19 Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven.

20 For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them.

21 Then came Peter to him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? till seven times?

22 Jesus saith unto him, I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven.

The beginning of our agreement with God is to forgive like He does. This clears our thinking to pursue spiritual things. Seven times are not enough times for me to forgive a person. Seventy times seven is 490 times. And that is in one day. God keeps score.

Jesus words were, “if two of you shall agree on earth.” This is a valid promise. It is a challenge to our spiritual man. It is an open door to heaven. With this one the door opens when the agreement is made. This promised door opens when an agreement is made between two people concerning a scripture. When you take it to a higher level, agreeing with Jesus makes Him your best partner in any situation.

With this Apostolic Cutting Edge let me agree with you that you will receive the blessings from God that He intended for you. Blessing number one: Casting all your cares on Him for He cares for you. Blessing number two: God will supply above your need this Christmas Season. Blessing number three: You will be able to give out of your one hand full. Eccl 4:6 Better is an handful with quietness, than both the hands full with travail and vexation of spirit. God loves a cheerful giver. God will take care of a cheerful giver.

The principle of this agreement is based on the words of Jesus. If you have lost a loved one you can agree with Jesus as your partner. The death of a loved one gives Jesus a great opportunity to become your partner in suffering grief. He is the best. I know from the experience of losing a 38 yr. old son.

Another sad thing is for your partner to have committed adultery and you are left alone. There are mixed emotions involved here. Take Jesus as your partner. He cares for you.

Another person I want to reach is the person who committed adultery and is sincerely repenting for it. JESUS is your partner also. You need Him because some people will never forgive you. They will not drop their stones. **You need to pray for them** that Jesus will help them to forgive you and drop their stones. John 8:7 Jesus said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her. Jesus has to say it. Your talking to them will get you nowhere.

Your happiness is in the Blood of Jesus. It will never lose its power. You are forgiven. God manifest in the flesh walked into His Temple and released the woman taken in adultery. He will do that for you. He will do that for your children also. But first He must become your partner in agreement. Let Jesus handle your problem.
