

Greetings from the top of the mountain.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, **he is faithful and just** to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Matt 6:14 For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you:
15 But if ye **forgive not** men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

By not forgiving a person you weaken your position with God. God's love is so strong for the sinner He died for him. By not forgiving a person that God would forgive, you position yourself above God. God can forgive without you **but He wants to forgive through you.**

2 Corinthians 2:10 To whom ye forgive any thing, I forgive also: for if I forgave any thing, to whom I forgave it, for your sakes forgave I it **in the person of Christ;**

You have power to forgive in Christ's stead. Wow. Think about that. When you say I forgive you it is forgiven in heaven. The Blood is applied to the person who has asked **your** forgiveness. You need to live the life of doing this. It will cause a person to believe you are **Apostolic.**

We are like the prodigal son. In the song ~ God's words to the prodigal son were ~ "My son I love you, You are forgiven, You still belong here, welcome back home. The family's waiting, to celebrate you, you are forgiven, welcome back home." ~ That is a beautiful song.

Do not withhold the Blood. Rejoice as a forgiven person and freely say, "**You are Forgiven.**" In your heart be willing to do it seventy times seven, in one day. God is counting so you do not have to. Just keep doing it. When you do that you have renewed their conscience **and your own.** The Blood has become their conscience. Satan cannot bring it up and use it against them because it is under the Blood. Their conscience is forgiven and clean. And **you** helped God do it. ~ Glory ~ Hallelujah ~ Praise God ~ Thank You Jesus.

This becomes a personal goal. Consult with yourself. Say to yourself, "this is what I want to be." The rule is ~ to reach a personal goal you must write it down. Then you view it often to plant it in your soul. You continually affirm this is what I want. When you do that, something happens in you. It works its way through your thinking until it becomes real. The Bible becomes clear and you find yourself doing it. When someone asks for your forgiveness you smile with joy and say, "You are Forgiven." It is thrilling to you and them. You realize you are working with the God of the Universe.

John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

Satan wants to destroy you with unforgiveness. He can steal the Word from your mind by diverting your attention to your weakness. We protect **ourselves** in our weak parts. We immediately think of ourselves and survival.

God wants you to be **strong** in Him and the **power of His Might.**

Eph 6:10 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.

11 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.
