The Law of the LORD governs our Life with an expected end.

Ps 19:7 The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple.

8 The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes.

9 The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether.

10 More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold: sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb.

11 Moreover by them is thy servant warned: and in keeping of them there is great reward.

The A-B-C's of Psalms 19:7-11

A. The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: (from death unto life)

Ps 119:158 I beheld the transgressors, and was grieved; because they kept not thy word.

159 Consider how I love thy precepts: quicken me, O LORD, according to thy lovingkindness.

B. the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple. (they can trust it)

Ps 119:130 The entrance of thy words giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the simple.

C. The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart: (you know that you know)

Ps 119:111 Thy testimonies have I taken as an heritage for ever: for they are the rejoicing of my heart.

D. the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes. (this is the way)

Ps 119:97 O how love I thy law! it is my meditation all the day.

98 Thou through thy commandments hast made me wiser than mine enemies: for they are ever with me.

99 I have more understanding than all my teachers: for thy testimonies are my meditation.

100 I understand more than the ancients, because I keep thy precepts.

Ps 119:140 Thy word is very pure: therefore thy servant loveth it.

E. The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring for ever: (cannot corrupt-all gold ever mined still exists)

Ps 119:160 Thy word is true from the beginning: and every one of thy righteous judgments endureth for ever.

F. the judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether. (everything about it is right)

Ps 119:128 Therefore I esteem all thy precepts concerning all things to be right; and I hate every false way.

G. More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold: (a desire beyond wealth)

Ps 119:127 Therefore I love thy commandments above gold; yea, above fine gold.

H. sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb. (taste and see that the LORD is good. Ps. 38:4.)

Ps 119:103 How sweet are thy words unto my taste! yea, sweeter than honey to my mouth!

I. Moreover by them is thy servant warned: (warned of danger)

Ps 119:101 I have refrained my feet from every evil way, that I might keep thy word.

102 I have not departed from thy judgments: for thou hast taught me.

J. and in keeping of them there is great reward. (in this life and in the life to come)

Ps 119:92 Unless thy law had been my delights, I should then have perished in mine affliction.

93 I will never forget thy precepts: for with them thou hast quickened me.
