

Enter this one humbly.

Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Prove to yourself that pity is a stronger position in your mind than pride. Pride will destroy you and cause you to fall. Pity will let you ~ show kindness, minister mercy, give relief to the afflicted and bring help to the wretched. Therefore: Be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind.

Pity is Love, making it much stronger than pride. Pity will settle you down. Pride will stir you up and upset you. It is who you think you are that makes the difference.

Luke 22:31 And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat:

32 But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.

33 And he said unto him, Lord, I am ready to go with thee, both into prison, and to death.

34 And he said, I tell thee, Peter, the cock shall not crow this day, before that thou shalt thrice deny that thou knowest me.

Pride messed up Peter's thinking in this situation. Peter actually denied that he knew Jesus. Jesus' **TOP** man failed Him. I have often thought about this story concerning how Jesus handled it. The pride of a boss would say: **You're Fired**. The heart of the Savior said nothing, **only showed pity to Peter**. And that pity got Peter from the crucifixion to Pentecost where he became the chief spokesman.

We are all guilty of acting from a position of pride. Even as I write this, conviction grips me. I can't go back and change it. However I can press forward with new knowledge on how to react with pity.

Matthew 18:21 Then came Peter to him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? till seven times?

22 Jesus saith unto him, I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven.

That is 490 times of showing pity. Is there no end to it? NO! His mercy endures forever.

Transformed from pride to pity is an eternal transformation. There is no end to LOVE!

Matthew 18:1 At the same time came the disciples unto Jesus, saying, **Who is the greatest** in the kingdom of heaven?

2 And Jesus called a little child unto him, and set him in the midst of them,

3 And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye **shall not enter** into the kingdom of heaven.

4 Whosoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child, **the same is greatest** in the kingdom of heaven.

Be ye transformed by renewing your mind and **You will become THE GREATEST !**

Pity is a strength not a weakness, so, pity the person who does you wrong 490 times.

Pity takes the fight out of you. Jesus wept over Jerusalem with pity.

This carries over into your prayer life. When you have no pity it hinders your prayers. Forgive them for they know not what they do is the correct way to pray. Learn to pity your enemies. They are a soul for whom Christ died. Forgive them from your heart or you will become a low class servant under Satan's control.
