Surrender – Lose it all

Every right implies a responsibility. To hold God to His promise I must be held to mine. God is bound, constrained, obliged to keep His promise, to follow a certain course of action. To obtain His promise I must obey His Word and totally surrender, to lose it all, to His Will. When I am not afraid to die I am not afraid to live. I can cast all my care on Him, knowing He cares for me.

Release God to perform His Word

2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind. What should I be doing right now? Turn your faith loose. Let it go. Let your faith fly like an eagle. God's greatest joy is to be believed. He wants us to release His Word into reality. Faith will do that. The key to faith is to release His Word into your spirit. Let it flow unhindered. In doing this you release God to do what He already wants to do. God wants to reveal Himself to the world through a person like you.

Speak words of release ~ like ~ I surrender all

2 Corinthians 8:12 For if there be first a willing mind, it is accepted according to that a man hath, and not according to that he hath not.

The first thing needed is a willing mind. To be compatible with God we must want His way. He can make up for all we lack in other things. He does this with His inspiration. What we say sounds so good it doesn't matter what part of the country we came from. Their mind is attracted to His inspired Word.

2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is **not slack** concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

God's Word is like a match. When you speak it ~ it lights with inspiration. It will accomplish its purpose. Isaiah 55:11 So shall **my word** be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper **in the thing whereto I sent it**.

Matthew 12:37 For by **thy words** thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned. Speak God's Word boldly. Speak your willingness boldly. Act boldly. Pursue boldly. There has to be a willingness to release yourself to God. I am willing to go where you want me to go. I am willing to say what you want me to say. I am willing to be what you want me to be. I am willing at any cost.

1 Samuel 30:8 And David inquired at the LORD, saying, Shall I **pursue** after this troop? shall I overtake them? And he answered him, **Pursue**: for thou shalt surely overtake them, and without fail recover all.

God is not done with you yet. Re-invent yourself. Attempt something new. Being willing at any cost puts you on the front line of the battle. Go looking for ways to help. Pray ~ God show me. Let me see it. Who can I help today? **Then ~ Pursue!** God will come out of the invisible into the visible. This kind of pursuit results in a joyful victory. You are tired but happy. Matthew 6:33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.
