Definitions of a Stronghold.

I enjoy everyone of them. Take your time and taste each prayerfully conceived one.

1. unmoving - unmovable
2. unchanging - unchangable
3. unadjusting - unadjustable
4. to hold fast
5. a strongly fortified defensive structure
6. the quality of being fixed in place
7. not in motion
8. fastened - cannot be unfastened
9. firm - cannot be disturbed
10. incapable of being changed or moved or undone, not changeable or subject to change, specified in advance
11. The clear and explicitly stated
12. securely in place
13. precisely determined or limited or denied
14. not capable of being moved
15. not capable of being adjusted
16. not likely to fail or give away
17. inaccessible - cannot be reached
18. frozen
19. perfect in it's beginning
20. Eternal

Now read them one right after the other about three times and feel the security of being fastened to HOPE!

1 Peter 2:20 For what glory is it, if, when ye be buffeted for your faults, ye shall take it patiently? but if, when ye do well, and suffer for it, ye take it patiently, this is acceptable with God.
