The Old Testament is already Confirmed in Heaven. It was the pattern used.

The purpose of the Old Testament was to provide 4000 years of human history.

The purpose of the New Testament was to provide 2000 years of human history.

The millennial will be another 1000 years of human history.

From these three periods God will divide three classes of people around the True Tabernacle in heaven. They will be the **Priests** = The Church ~ Then the **Levites** = The Tribulation Saints ~ and then the **twelve tribes** = the White Throne Righteous.

The Old Testament Tabernacle was a shadow ~ a pattern ~ Heb 8:5 Who serve unto the example and shadow of heavenly things, as Moses was admonished of God when he was about to make the tabernacle: for, See, saith he, *that* thou make all things **according to the pattern** shewed to thee in the mount.

The Tabernacle was laid out in the shadow of a cross. Each piece of furniture fits the Plan of Salvation. Death of Repentance was at the Brazen Altar. Water Baptism in Jesus name was at the Laver of Water. A new life was received just inside the first curtain in the Holy Place. Here the priest saw by the light of the Candlestick, ate of the Table of Showbread, and at the Altar of Incense he offered prayers, knowing his God dwelt just beyond the Curtain, called the Veil. Inside the Holy of Holies were the Ark and The Mercy seat where God dwelt.

New Testament Confirmed

There is a True Tabernacle in Heaven. Jesus is referred to in ~ Hebrews 8:2 A minister of the sanctuary, and of the true tabernacle, which the Lord pitched, and not man.

There will be gathered around this True Tabernacle and it's High Priest ~ the Church, the tribulation saints and the White Throne Righteous, three classes of people

This is definitely not the time to live in unbelief. The Bible is True!

Matthew 25:5 While the bridegroom tarried, they all slumbered and slept.

6.And at midnight there was a cry made, Behold, the bridegroom cometh; go ye out to meet him.

1Corinthians 15:52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.
