

**197-The word Trinity is an excuse. Go back to the Bible for the Truth-04-09-10**

Romans 1:20 For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are **clearly seen**, being understood by the things that are made, **even his eternal power and Godhead**; so that they are **without excuse**: Jesus did not outline a Trinity of persons in Matthew 28:19. He outlined the **fullness** of His Name. **Do not think it is a mystery. You can know. It is all in Him.**

The best information I can give you is information you can check out for yourself.

The word Trinity is a false word with no promise. It was not so from the beginning.

Defining the Trinity is the Philosophy of a man. Theophilus 168-183 AD first used the word.

That is 100 years after the Bible was written. Luke's 70 year history gives you God's Oath.

**The Trinity that did not exist from Genesis to Revelation**

**You do not need to know the Greek language to check this one.** The King James Version is enough to know there is but One God. When anyone obeys Acts 2:38, that person is an English translation of the Greek, confirming there is but One God. God does not hide Himself in any language. God reveals Himself in one picture seen in all languages.

Colosians 2:8 Beware lest any **man** spoil you **through philosophy** and **vain deceit**, after the **tradition of men**, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ.

9 For **in him dwelleth** all the **fulness** of the Godhead bodily.

10 And **ye are complete in him**, which is **the head of all** principality and power:

**God's approach had to be as a legitimate man so that a man got the credit. God revealed His love for man by becoming a man. Now we are impersonating Him over and over again.**

A Greek named **Theophilus** - in 168-183 AD - first used the word Trinity. He spoiled Matthew 28:19 through philosophy and vain deceit. He couldn't change Matthew's Greek copy. It was already written 100 years earlier. The Greek word for a singular Name had to stay. Theophilus' philosophy was there were three separate distinct persons in the Godhead. This could not fit into One God Who is everywhere. Therefore He wrote a definition that **even he couldn't explain**. He deceived by calling it a **mystery**. His philosophy was that people would believe it **and they do**.

In doing this Theophilus had an excuse for changing water baptism from Jesus Name to using the words Father, Son and Holy Ghost. Thus water baptism became more philosophical than a requirement. Many call it an outward sign of an inward change. That is far different from Jesus reason for water baptism in His Name. Baptism in Jesus Name is for remission of sins. You become Heaven Clean.

It was also first used in Latin by **Tertullian** ~ 220 AD. **It was not so from the beginning.** The word trinity is not found in Scripture. It was not needed until men ceased to believe in Acts 2:38. This took a period of about 125 years. **Then it became their excuse.** It corrupted the belief in the one true God. God is a Spirit. God is everywhere. There is no room for another god. He is God in creation. He is God in redemption. He is God in manifestation. He is God in eternity. The one thing God wants the world to know and believe is that **He is One**.

The reason God became a man was so He could pay the price for sin by dying on the cross. A **man** had to do it. God became the **only man** who could do it. To shift the **whole purpose of God** into a **philosophy of man** is unthinkable. It's the **Blood of a man** that remits sins. An innocent man's blood was shed. God became a man to obtain a purpose.

In Matthew 28:19 Jesus proclaimed the **oneness** of **His Name**. It's all in Him.

The word Trinity is an **excuse** for not believing **God's Oath** in **Acts 2:38**. The **trouble is not** with the facts -- the **trouble is** drawing **unclear** and **dishonest** inferences from the facts of Matthew 28:19. These words were **not used - nor intended to be used** - in the Bible for water baptism.

You can trace the word trinity only so far back then it disappears. You can't trace it any further. The word trinity is not found in the Bible. It was first used by the Greek Theophilus around 168-183 AD. It was designed by **the mind of a man**. It is a **Greek invented word** that will **mess you up**. It was an excuse to **replace** water baptism in Jesus Name, used in Acts 2:38, with water baptism using the titles found in Matthew 28:19. **God is One. Gal. 3:20.**
