

Let the following scriptures inspire you. God has no other plan.

#1. 1 Cor 2:1 And I, brethren, when I came to you, came not with excellency of speech or of wisdom, declaring unto you the testimony of God.

2 For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and him crucified.

3 And I was with you in weakness, and in fear, and in much trembling.

4 And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:

5 That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.

#2. We are being called upon to do the things we cannot do. (neither can we explain them)

Revelation causes a Revolution inside us.

This makes us a radical, but, a smart radical.

It's not what we see, but, what we can not see and yet believe. Luke is a good example. Luke did not see Jesus.

And there is a report to be made. Heb 11:2 For by it the elders obtained a good report.

God has given to every man a measure of faith.

#3. Rom 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Faith can be increased.

#4. 2 Cor 10:13 But we will not boast of things without our measure, but according to the measure of the rule which God hath distributed to us, a measure to reach even unto you.

14 For we stretch not ourselves beyond our measure, as though we reached not unto you: for we are come as far as to you also in preaching the gospel of Christ:

#5. John 12:24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit.

#6. Luke 17:5 And the apostles said unto the Lord, Increase our faith.

6 And the Lord said, If ye had faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye might say unto this sycamine tree, Be thou plucked up by the root, and be thou planted in the sea; and it should obey you.

Verses 7 thru 10 showed them what their problem was in their belief system. **They were saying the words of the servant and not the Land Owner**.

#7. Jesus wanted them to be the master of their problem and speak His Word to their problem.

He is telling them if they had faith they would speak, they would take the responsibility of saying it.

Speak the Word.

#8. 2 Cor 4:13 We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak;

#9. Rom 10:6 But the righteousness which is of faith speaketh on this wise, Say not in thine heart, Who shall ascend into heaven? (that is, to bring Christ down from above:)

7 Or, Who shall descend into the deep? (that is, to bring up Christ again from the dead.)

8 But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach;

The wild birds wake up bankrupt every morning.

#10. God knows what He is doing. He put giving in our nature.

#11. Matt 25:14 For the kingdom of heaven is as a man travelling into a far country, who called his own servants, and delivered unto them his goods.

#12. God is not trying to get our goods, but, is trying to get His goods to us, His stewards. Do what He says. Seed sowed in a sack is reaped in a wagon, so we can distribute His goods to others.

#13. Hag 2:8 The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, saith the LORD of hosts.

#14. Ps 24:1 The earth is the LORD's, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein.

#15. Dan 11:32 but the people that do know their God shall be strong, and do exploits. (daring, heroic)
