

209-Why do ye not understand my speech-07-02-10

John 8:43 Why do ye not understand my speech? **even because ye cannot hear my word.**

Romans 10:17 So then **faith cometh by hearing**, and hearing by the word of God.

Do not try to do things only God can do. Have Faith in God and don't muzzle the ox treading the corn.

No one knows everything, therefore, this one is for all of us in our lack of knowledge and faith in Him.

Jesus' Full Question.

1. Through what cause? What is the reason? Why? Wherefore do you not understand?
2. You do not reason, allow yourself to be made aware of, to perceive, to resolve, to be sure of my Word.
3. Because of this you cannot hear my talk, my saying, my speech.
4. Concerning your neglect, you let my words pass over you, as though they were not for you, thus, losing an opportunity to receive power to overcome the things of this world
5. Look at the word "can" plus "not." You do the "not" part. Can plus nothing is the absolute negative.

Jesus explained the answer about how to hear His Word and have faith.

Jesus question, "Why do ye not understand my speech" has to do with the **hearing** of His **Words**. It involves The Apostolic Doctrine He formulated and The Apostolic Cutting Edge He set in motion when He ascended into Heaven from the Mount of Olives.

Jesus question has to do with ~ His account of life, cause and communication. It concerns His doctrine, fame, and has to do with the intent, matter, mouth, preaching, question, reason, plus reckon, remove, say, speaker, speech, talk, thing, plus none of these things move me, tidings, treatise, utterance, *word*, work.

Listen clearly to the teaching words of Jesus in this scripture.

Luke 9:44 Let these sayings **sink down into your ears**: for the Son of man shall be delivered into the hands of men.

Let Jesus sharpen your wisdom ~ you will hear and understand more.

Ecclesiastes 10:10 If the iron be blunt, and he do not whet the edge, then must he put to more strength: but wisdom is profitable to direct.

Proverbs 27:17 Iron sharpeneth iron; so a man sharpeneth the countenance of his friend.

2 Timothy 2:11 It is a faithful saying: For if we be dead with him, we shall also live with him:
