

Proverbs 4:7 Wisdom is **the principal thing**; therefore get wisdom: and with all thy getting get **understanding**.

Doing something the wise way is easier than working harder with less knowledge about your project. This means that wisdom dominates work. You have dominion over your work when you do it the wise way. Work becomes fun. Wisdom is the principal thing. It is number one. The companion to wisdom is understanding. The wisdom of doing something requires an understanding of how to use your wisdom. The key is to: **Start and don't stop.**

How to perform that which is good

Turn not to the right nor to the left.

Let it move you forward to your new position in Christ.

God teaches us what to think and how to think it. The carnal man resists this. The carnal man says, don't tell me what to think. Don't tell me how to think. This I know because I was there. I did not want anyone messing with my mind. I remember it and this was the biggest mistake of my life.
