

**222-The sin which doth so easily beset us is unbelief-10-01-10**

Hebrews 12:1 **Wherefore seeing** we also are compassed about with **so great a cloud of witnesses**, let us **lay aside every weight**, and **the sin which doth so easily beset us**, and let us run with **patience** the race that is **set before us**,
