

223-Receiving new wisdom from God to make cunning work-10-08-10

Exodus 35:31 And he hath filled him with the spirit of God, in wisdom, in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship;
32 And to devise curious works, to work in gold, and in silver, and in brass,
33 And in the cutting of stones, to set them, and in carving of wood, to make any manner of cunning work.
34 And he hath put in his heart that he may teach, both he, and Aholiab, the son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan.

Israel was in Egypt 430 years. The only skills they had at this time in Exodus was brick making. They lost favor with the Pharaoh that knew not Joseph and were made brick making slaves. They were born, grew up and died as brick makers. We, as sinners, were born into this world and knew nothing about living for God. When Jesus brought us out we had to learn new skills for living. Learn them well.

Open your mind to the Words of Jesus. Concentrate!

John 6:63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.

Here is our new skill. If we say the same words Jesus said our words also are spirit and they are life.

2 Timothy 4:2 Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. We have the authority to do this.

Memorize the Word. Be like Jeremiah in Lamentations.

Lamentations 3:21 This I recall to my mind, therefore have I hope.

22 It is of the Lord's mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not.

23 They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness.

24 The Lord is my portion, saith my soul; therefore will I hope in him.

25 The Lord is good unto them that wait for him, to the soul that seeketh him.

26 It is good that a man should both hope and quietly wait for the salvation of the Lord.

I have built into my mind a "recall database" of God's Word. I preach it to myself more than to others. I do this, sometimes at 3 am. I cast all my cares on Him, because He cares for me, and He lets me go to sleep. The Bible says: He gives His beloved sleep. Psalms 127:2 It is vain for you to rise up early, to sit up late, to eat the bread of sorrows: for so he giveth his beloved sleep.

A Scripture database on your Laptop will not work in an emergency. Build your database in your mind while you are young. You will continually need and use it. The older you get the more you need this database. The eyes grow dim and the ears do not hear as well as they used to. You survive on what you have accumulated in your heart. Make your database your main goal in life. It will be the last thing you will lean on as you believe God until the end.
