

**225-King David said ~ I hate every false way-10-22-10**

When you understand how God's Word works, you will fully understand David's statement.

Ps 119:104 Through thy precepts I get understanding: therefore *I hate every false way.*

Ps 119:113 I hate vain thoughts: but thy law do I love.

114 Thou art my hiding place and my shield: I hope in thy word.

Ps 119:128 Therefore I esteem all thy precepts concerning all things to be right; and *I hate every false way.*

129 Thy testimonies are wonderful: therefore doth my soul keep them.

**130 The entrance of thy words giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the simple.**

Ps 17:4 Concerning the works of men, by the word of thy lips I have kept me from the paths of the destroyer.

Ps 68:11 The Lord gave the word: great was the company of those that published it.

The characteristics of God's Word are opposed to the characteristic of the word HATE.

The word hate was given to us by God to be used against Satan. Some use it against people and that is wrong.

David said: "I hate every false way because it leads me astray from the truth I really need."

This is the reason we need to keep the Apostolic Message alive. We need to proclaim it loud and clear.

The following words of Jesus are forever settled in heaven.

Luke 24:44 And he said unto them, These are the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the law of Moses, and in the prophets, and in the psalms, concerning me.

45 Then opened he their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures,

46 And said unto them, Thus it is written, and thus it behoved Christ to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day:

47 And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

48 And ye are witnesses of these things.

I love those words and I hate every false way. They are a lamp unto my feet and a light to my path. They shine forward toward my perfect day when I shall be like Him and with Him forever. No more sorrow, disappointment, weakness, sad memories, loss of memory, constraints, etc. A little later, in Luke 24:50-53, Jesus ascended to heaven, from the Mount of Olives, thus beginning The Apostolic Cutting Edge that we now live on. Jesus left, recorded in Light, His Plan of Salvation for all to believe.

I am glad I was born into this world to partake of this wonderful Salvation. My mother and father taught me the way more perfectly, as in Acts 2:38. My father left in the dark of the morning to go to work in the coal mine. He would always pray, low but out loud, before he left. I heard him many a morning. We always prayed before every meal. Godly discipline was a regular in our home for all eleven of us kids. We were taught not to say bad words. I remember, as a very young boy, asking my mother if the "f" word was a bad word. I will never forget her shock at hearing me say that word. She said "YES" very clear! She followed with ~ "Don't you ever say that word again." I heard her counseling a neighbor girl with these words: "Why would you give your body to that boy to sin with?" The world has changed very much since then but "Abstain from fornication is still in the Bible." 1 Thessalonians 4:3 For this is the will of God, even your sanctification, that ye should abstain from fornication: 4 That every one of you should know how to possess his vessel in sanctification and honour.
