5. **The seed puts a demand on respect.** A man deceives himself when he thinks he does not have to respect things the way God made them. Respect is love. Be glad God has given you a place to exist. You are His greatest creation. Respect and appreciate that. Let the seed work inside of you.

6. **The seed puts a demand on Obedience.** With the previous demands met you are now ready to bring into reality the new idea God trusted you with. Determine to do it.
