

Does it matter how a person is baptized? Yes. Repentance and remission of sins are accomplished through His Name in water baptism. It was the **purpose** of His death. Luke 24:45 Then opened he their understanding, that they might **understand** the scriptures,

46 And said unto them, Thus it is written, and thus **it behoved Christ** (must needs be) to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day:

47 And that **repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name** among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

48 And ye are witnesses of these things. (Jesus baptized His disciples qualifying them to baptize 3000.)

Man is vain. He **continually** tries to improve **the carnal man**. There is a place of **rest** in God. Find it and rest. The Sabbath was made for man. Find your Sabbath and rest in God. You will never know it all.

Deut 29:29 The secret things belong unto the LORD our God: but those things which are **revealed** belong unto **us and to our children** for ever, that we may do all the words of this law.

There are people who can speak many languages. I admire them. I think it's great. However, you do not need to know the Greek Language to understand the Bible. The Spirit of Christ and the English Language do it quite well. People today are Repenting of their sins, being baptized in Jesus Name for the remission of their sins and receiving the Holy Ghost speaking with tongues as they did in Acts chapter two. **These people** are the **literal translation** from the Greek language Luke wrote into the English language we speak today.

Eyewitnesses gave Luke his information in the Gospel of Luke and the first 15 chapters of The Acts. God anointed Luke to write his Books with His Oath of "Surely I did it." That's powerful. An Oath ends all strife. There is no argument left in me. The Spirit of Christ and the English translation of Luke **gives me** a **perfect understanding** of all things from the beginning.

God made it so plain to Luke that he wrote:

Luke 1:3 It seemed good to me also, **having had perfect understanding of all things from the very first**, to write unto thee **in order**, most excellent Theophilus,

4 That thou mightest **know the certainty** of those things, wherein thou hast been instructed.

God's concern for us is seen in the following:

Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; **but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.**

The sinner does not need to know the Greek language to find the way he should live. He just needs to know Jesus. The Spirit of Christ and the English language will take it from there. **Just tell the Story. But tell it all.** Make it plain for all to see

That was Luke's mission, his calling and his purpose. Luke recorded the whole counsel of God in Luke 24:46-47 and Acts chapter 2. God intends for every generation to hear His Story. There will be people in heaven from every tribe, tongue, people, and nation. Those on the mission field should read it again and rejoice. Everyone should read it again and rejoice. Then, go tell it all again. This is the Rest that will cause the weary to rest, this is the refreshing. If you are weary this is your refreshing. Refresh yourself in it today. Isaiah 28:12.
