Luke's decision put him in Philippi for about 5 years, while Paul went on his third missionary journey. On Paul's way back, he went by Philippi and Luke joined him on the journey to Jerusalem. Luke's assuredly gathering took on a new meaning. There were eyewitnesses of Jesus life and teaching still alive in the Jerusalem area. Luke met a man in Philippi by the name of Theophilus. Luke's calling was to obtain eyewitness information for Theophilus. By assuredly gathering, Luke wrote the Gospel of Luke and the Book of The Acts of The Apostles to Theophilus.

Luke 1:1 Forasmuch as many have taken in hand to set forth in order a declaration of those things which are most surely believed among us,

2 Even as they delivered them unto us, which from the beginning were eyewitnesses, and ministers of the word;

3 It seemed good to me also, having had perfect understanding of all things from the very first, to write unto thee in order, most excellent Theophilus,

4 That thou mightest know the certainty of those things, wherein thou hast been instructed.

God has given us Things For Certain.

Use a Bible Concordance to gather scriptures about your subject. Gather with assurance. All men can renew a weary mind with God's Word. Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove (first to yourself) what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
