48 And ye are witnesses of these things.
49 And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.
50 And he led them out as far as to Bethany, and he lifted up his hands, and blessed them.
51 And it came to pass, while he blessed them, he was parted from them, and carried up into heaven.
52 And they worshipped him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy:
53 And were continually in the temple, praising and blessing God. Amen.

The Physical Teacher was gone. The Apostolic Cutting Edge had begun. We were left to study His teachings. There is no end to that in this life. It continues into our day.

Luke was a Gentile, an alien from the commonwealth of Israel. He was without God, having no hope. In Luke 2:25-32 the old man Simeon foresaw Jesus as the one to lighten the Gentiles. Luke was an enlightened Gentile qualified to write the Gospel of Luke and the book of The Acts of the Apostles. No man is really qualified to study the Epistles and Revelation effectively until he has mastered and experienced ~ by obeying ~ the book of Luke and the book of Acts. On these two books hang all of the Old and New Testament. The salvation of the soul that Jesus died for is pre-told in the Old Testament and referred to by Jesus himself in Luke 24:44 ~ then Fulfilled" in Acts. There is no early church to write an epistle to, until they obey what Jesus said to do.

Jesus, in (The real) Great Commission given in Luke 24:45-49 said: "Repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His Name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem." Luke wrote this ~ that the world may know. This is why Christ Died.

Understanding Luke and Acts is a prerequisite. It is a requirement to advance. It is obligatory. It is a prior condition. It is morally binding. You must understand how to get into the church before you can really know what's going on in the church. The Epistles and Revelation were written to the churches about how to live now that they are in the church. How to be saved is foretold in the book of Luke and fulfilled in the book of Acts. How to stay saved follows the book of Acts starting with the Book of Romans. The Church in Rome was started by the Romans and proselytes mentioned in Acts 2:10. They obeyed Peter's message and took the Church back to Rome with them.

There are some who believe in a Roman's road to Salvation which is taken from the Book of Romans. This is why you cannot pick and choose. The road to the Roman Church leads from Jerusalem on the Day of Pentecost back to Rome. Salvation did not come out of Rome it went back to Rome. You cannot understand the Book of Romans until you understand Luke and Acts. Luke's writings magnify Christianity in a way only God and Luke could have done it.

God designed every man with a spiritual desire. Some men trample it under their feet so they can feed their own lusts. Others follow after it so they may please God. God made man to be a hunter. He is always hunting something. Harness the hunter in you to hunt the scriptures and find God's will for your life.
