Acts 13:22 And when he had removed him, he raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also he gave testimony, and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after mine own heart, which shall fulfil all my will.

Welcome to the morning that is in my heart. I have a vision that this Newsletter will accomplish its purpose. A visionary is a person with unusual powers of foresight. God wants to put Luke 24:45-50 in the hands of a Visionary.

If you could hear what I see, you would wake up every morning to the mercies of God and have Revival in your heart. Luke wrote 27.6 % of the New Testament. He covered 75 years of history, (5 BC - 70 AD) that ended when Titus destroyed Jerusalem. Ears to hear means you have **eyes to see what you hear**. God invented words to convey pictures to our mind. Then He inspired men to write His Word for us to first hear and then see in our spirit. Happy are our eyes when we become a doer of His word in this fashion. Seeing and hearing is believing and doing.

Jesus spoke in parables to confuse the unbelievers. When He quoted scripture they spoke out against Him. When He spoke a parable they quietly said: "I don't get it." To the person opposed to Christianity the words of Jesus are foolishness. Take a look at the things that are foolishness to men. Then take look at the things that are foolishness to God. Take Your Pick.

1 Corinthians 2:14 But the **natural man** receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

1 Corinthians 3:19 For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, He taketh the wise in their own craftiness.

Catch the Vision of Luke. Run with it.

In every generation God will raise up a man after His own heart. Every generation needs its own man. In this world every generation has to fight for its own freedom. There is always someone or something to challenge the good with evil. This is why some wars **must** be fought. The alternative is to lose our freedom. We are living in just such a day.
