All of the New Testament writers repented, were baptized in Jesus Name and received the Holy Ghost speaking with other tongues as the Spirit gave the utterance. The proof is there. You just need to search it out. I Did. Here it is. Look in the Rec. Exp. Column on the Chart.

The New Testament is not fragmented

Look at this line up of the Eight Authors of 27 Books. Observe their unified Character. They wrote as one Church with no contradiction. With eyes to see and ears to hear we are made aware that the New Testament is not fragmented but consistent in all parts. Luke begins his story earlier in BC 5 and John ends his in 95 AD. All the writers had the same experience as those in the Upper Room on the Day of Pentecost. Luke and Paul were the only ones not there on Pentecost but received the same experience later. Paul had his personal experience on the road to Damascus. At that point Paul repented. He was baptized in Jesus Name and filled with the Holy Ghost in Acts 9:17-18.

Notice Paul had only one message.

1Corinthians 4:17 For this cause have I sent unto you Timotheus, who is my beloved son, and faithful in the Lord, who shall bring you into remembrance of my ways which be in Christ, **as I teach everywhere in every church**. Paul, in Acts 19:1-7, taught the Ephesians how to be **saved by Grace through faith**. It was by obeying the Acts 2:38 message Jesus had revealed to him personally. Acts 19:5 When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. 6 And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied.

Luke had received his experience. When Paul saw the vision, Luke said in Acts 16:10, And after he had seen the vision, **immediately we** endeavored to go into Macedonia, assuredly gathering that the **Lord had called us** for to preach the gospel unto them. Mark grew up in the church and received his own experience. He later became profitable to Paul in his Ministry in Rome. 2 Timothy 4:11.

All books in the New Testament were written after the Day of Pentecost. Combining Luke with Acts, Luke wrote 27.6 %, over one fourth of the New Testament. The Apostle Paul wrote 28.5 % in his Epistles. Luke and Paul together wrote 56.1 % , over one half of the New Testament. Mark wrote 8.2 %. The other Apostles, Matthew, John, James, Peter and Jude combined wrote 35.7 % a total of 100 %. I counted the pages.

All the writers had experienced repentance, water baptism in Jesus Name and the infilling of the Holy Ghost speaking with other tongues as the spirit gave them utterance. God is smart. His purpose was to **keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace**. That Spirit is written into it and is still there.

Ephesians 4:5. One Lord, one faith, one baptism, 6. One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.
