

Luke 12:56 - How is it that you do not discern?

Too taken up with the things of the flesh.

We can discern this time of opportunity through A Relationship with God.

We have two choices – Accept or reject.

Things which belong to thy peace

Gal 6:10 As we have therefore opportunity, let us do good unto all men, especially unto them who are of the household of faith.

Heb 7:19 For the law made nothing perfect, but the bringing in of a better hope did; by the which we draw nigh unto God.

James 4:8 Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded.

Matt 7:23 And then will I profess unto them, **I never knew you**: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

Luke 12:54 And he said also to the people, When ye see a cloud rise out of the west, straightway ye say, There cometh a shower; and so it is.

55 And when ye see the south wind blow, ye say, There will be heat; and it cometh to pass.

56 Ye hypocrites, ye can discern the face of the sky and of the earth; but how is it that ye do not discern this time?
