Jochebed was assigned to a high position. Think about it. She put the foundation into the life of Moses who would lead the Children of Israel into the Promised Land. It was promised by God and Moses was the man who would get them there. And He did. Moses got them to the Jordan River and died. Joshua led them across the Jordan river into Jericho.

God can do some amazing things. He moved the heart of Pharaoh's daughter to allow Moses mother to raise him and she paid her to do it. Because of this arrangement Moses was learned in all the ways of the Egyptians. This later qualified him to lead the Children of Israel out of Egypt into the Promised Land.

Ex 2:1 And there went a man of the house of Levi, and took to wife a daughter of Levi.

2 And the woman (Jochebed) conceived, and bare a son: and when she saw him that he was a goodly child, she hid him three months.

3 And when she could not longer hide him, she took for him an ark of bulrushes, and daubed it with slime and with pitch, and put the child therein; and she laid it in the flags by the river's brink.

4 And his sister stood afar off, to wit what would be done to him.

5 And the daughter of Pharaoh came down to wash herself at the river; and her maidens walked along by the river's side; and when she saw the ark among the flags, she sent her maid to fetch it.

6 And when she had opened it, she saw the child: and, behold, the babe wept. And she had compassion on him, and said, This is one of the Hebrews' children.

7 Then said his sister to Pharaoh's daughter, Shall I go and call to thee a nurse of the Hebrew women, that she may nurse the child for thee?

8 And Pharaoh's daughter said to her, Go. **And the maid went and called the child's mother.**

9 And Pharaoh's daughter said unto her, Take this child away, and nurse it for me, and I will give thee thy wages. And the woman took the child, and nursed it.

10 And the child grew, and she brought him unto Pharaoh's daughter, and he became her son. **And she called his name Moses: and she said, Because I drew him out of the water.**

The story is one continual time line. We are on our way to the promised land. There have been many leaders. We need leaders who can steer the Church through the maze of many who assume a leadership roll but are blinded because of their teacher. John 8:43 Why do ye not understand my speech? even **because ye cannot hear my word.**

Hearing is getting the correct picture Jesus intended for us to see. Luke 24:46 And said unto them, Thus it is written, and thus it behoved Christ to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day:

47 And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

48 And ye are witnesses of these things.

Jesus instructed us to be witnesses of verse 47. Acts 2:37 Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do?

38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

39 For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call.
