

God has imbedded His Word into our conscience thus driving us forward with anticipation. Our conscience is our motivating guide. Our conscience is based on our understanding of God's Word. That is the highest knowledge there is. We cannot do what we do not know so study the Word. We can do the Word. Think about that. Look at where the inspiration is found. It is within your driving distance.

Inspired by the Word we live in anticipation of the results. Knowing - His promise cannot fail - we anticipate it with excitement. Is anything too hard for the Lord? This should get us up and running through an open door every morning - sending us on our way rejoicing. Yes – in the morning.

What is your need? Pin point it. Be specific. Faith is the substance of your need. Faith is the evidence of what you do not have as of yet. You must see it as a substance already in existence - so real you can offer it to yourself as evidence that it does exist. Live in anticipation of His Word and you will have it. Genesis 11:6 - and now **nothing** will be **restrained** from them, which they have **imagined** to do. It is important to have eyes to see – because - once you see it you can do it.

Put your name in this verse and live in anticipation.

Philippians 4:19 But my God shall supply **all your need** (Al Friend) according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus. (expect it)

God put a **goal** in His Word. There is a **reason** we should be willing to obey and die for it. That reason is we can be delivered from oppression and be saved through His Blood. Sooner is better - - You get to enjoy it longer. The most outstanding thing is Deliverance. Changed. From death to life. From a bad guy to a good guy. From a bad day to a good day. From depression to anticipation. WOW! Hey – Wait a minute – come back here. I am still talking to you.

Led by your conscience - you can live life in anticipation of the good things to come. We have a better covenant based on better promises than they had under the Law. Hebrews 9:11 But Christ being come an high priest of **good things to come**, Hebrews 8:6 But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a **better covenant**, which was established upon **better promises**.

Paul realized the stress of his day was normal living. He lived in the anticipation of pressing toward the mark. Your spirit can be happy doing this. You have a purpose.

Philippians 3:13 Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but **this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind**, and **reaching forth** unto those **things which are before**, 14 **I press** toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.

First get in the yoke of a promise of God. He is in the yoke pulling with you. He wants you to succeed. Take advantage of the inspiration of being in the yoke with Him. There is a reason. He is the reason. Learn to live in anticipation of what God is doing with you in the yoke of His Word. It is important that you let Him set the pace.

We live on the cutting edge of life. We breathe in our future, we exhale our past. We deal with only two emotions – Fear and Love. Love has the sharper edge and can cut away fear. Fear has the dullest edge and cannot cut away love. Anticipate winning with love.
